It appears there is an error in the lettering sequence in the RFA on page 9.</p> <p>g) Describe how FSC’s inform parents/guardians of their rights and procedural h) safeguards within the FIT Program. i) Describe how FSC’s will assist families in accessing training, leadership opportunities, and connection with other parents/guardians.</p>	<p>Pursuant to the RFA Mandatory Requirements, pg. 5, the RFA states: <i><u>“Narrative Response: Using a narrative format, please provide the following information”.</u></i></p> <p>Therefore, you do not have to “outline” your response. Responses should be provided using a narrative format.</p>
<p>Are there any documents that should be attached, other than a written description for Supporting Document C, to show financial stability and our ability to cover payroll while awaiting reimbursement?</p>	<p>Pursuant to the RFA Mandatory Requirements, pg. 10, regarding Supporting Documents, item C, the RFA states: <i><u>“Describe the Offeror’s financial status, including the results of any recent audits, and ability to meet expenditures, including payroll of proposed staff, of up to eight weeks awaiting reimbursement.”</u></i></p> <p>The RFA Mandatory Requirement to this criteria does not request Applicants to “attach” documents related to financial status, audits, etc. If the Applicant provides any documents that was not required in the RFA, the Evaluation Committee will not review those items.</p> <p>The Applicant shall only provide requested information that is required in accordance with the RFA Requirements.</p>
<p>I am needing clarification as to reimbursement for this grant; are they only reimbursable through Medicaid or are services</p>	<p>All providers who provide services under this agreement <u>must be able to bill Medicaid</u>. Reimbursement comes from a combination of State General Funds administered through ECECD and Medicaid funds,</p>

If a provider is not able to bill Medicaid at the onset of the agreement, they will be required to become a Medicaid reimbursable provider as soon as possible in order to receive Medicaid reimbursement.</p>
